The first in a new series of lectures presented by Friends of the Museum will be Justin Ward's *Etching in the Footsteps of the Masters*. Justin discusses the process and historical development of etching and printmaking, an art form that dates back to the Middle Ages. Through years of experience and research Justin has developed a passion and unique perspective for this process that he wishes to expound to art lovers the world over.

Justin Ward has worked as a graphic designer and art director for the last several years of his career. While pursuing his life long love of printmaking, he soon developed his lecture series, *Etching in the Footsteps of the Masters*. As a self taught printmaker Justin has been inspired by such artists as James McNeill Whistler and Monterey's own Armin Hansen. With the inspiration of these artists, and that of the beautiful geography of the Monterey Peninsula, he has created several works that are now sold and shown in local galleries and permanent collections.

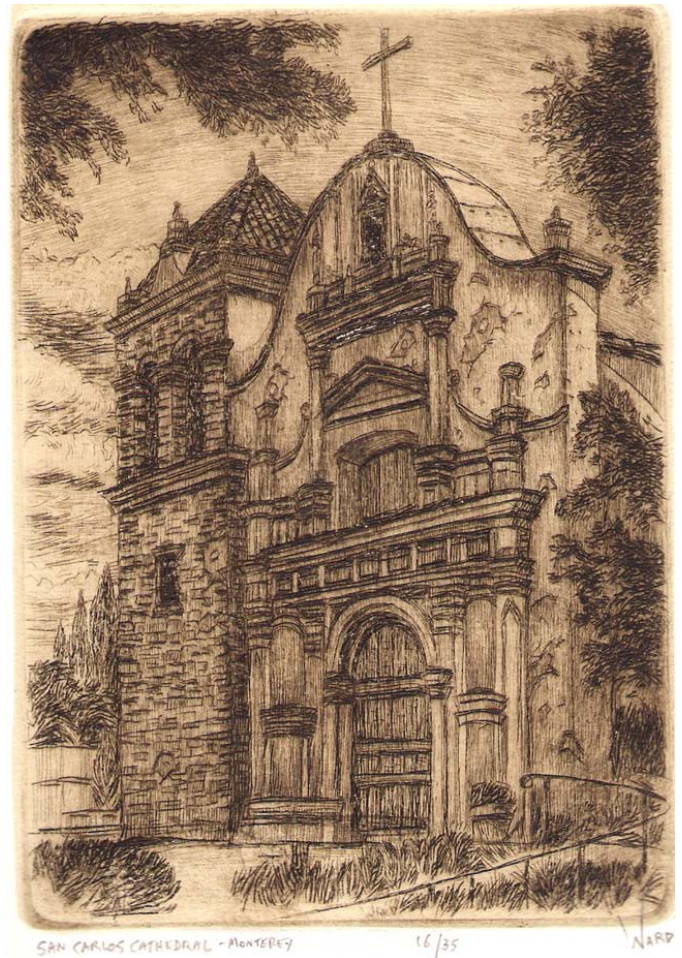
